A young woman leaves the town she grew up in, all her friends and connections and escapes a violent home environment with her baby. She drives away in tears from everything she is familiar with until she runs out of gas. Tired, cold, alone and with no money to buy her little girl diapers, she calls a "help line". Even though it's after 8 pm on a Friday night, the Director answers the phone, drives to find the young woman, addresses her immediate needs and finds a safe place for her to stay. The following day, they meet to discuss a plan to find more permanent housing, classes to help her qualify for a good job and most importantly, hope! An elderly man with a workplace injury finally runs out of resources after 8 months of somehow finding a way to make ends meet. He locates an agency and talks with the staff to learn if there's a way to keep his power on. As the conversation progresses, the staff learns that this man is a Viet Nam veteran who has been living with no knowledge of the military benefits he has earned. They help him apply for his pension, put a plan in place to stabilize his housing and help him look forward to a life of dignity and honor.
